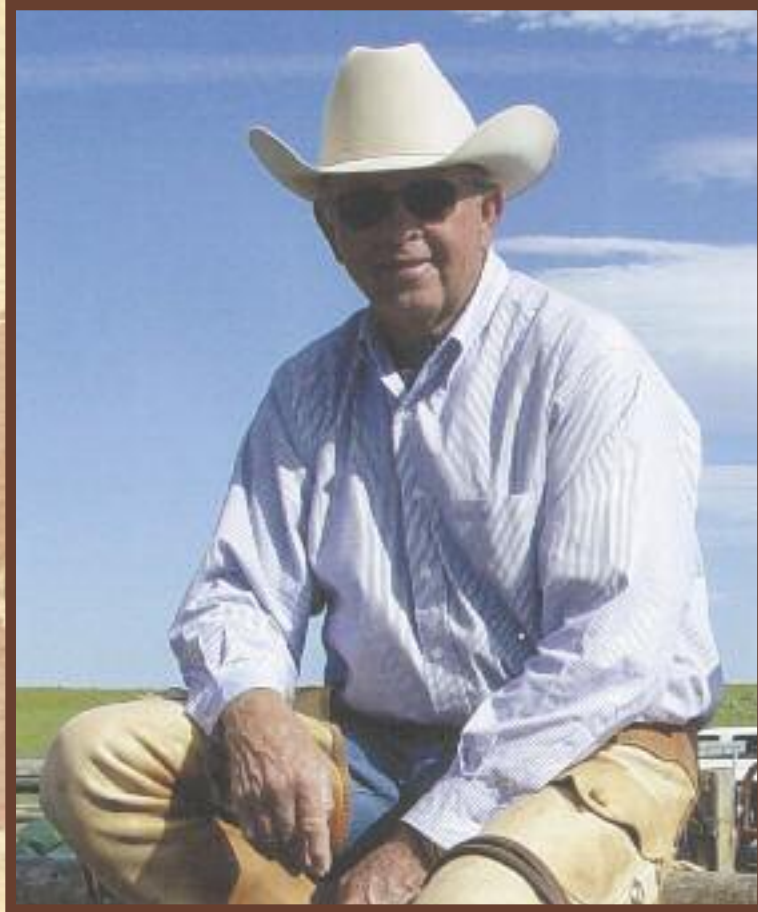

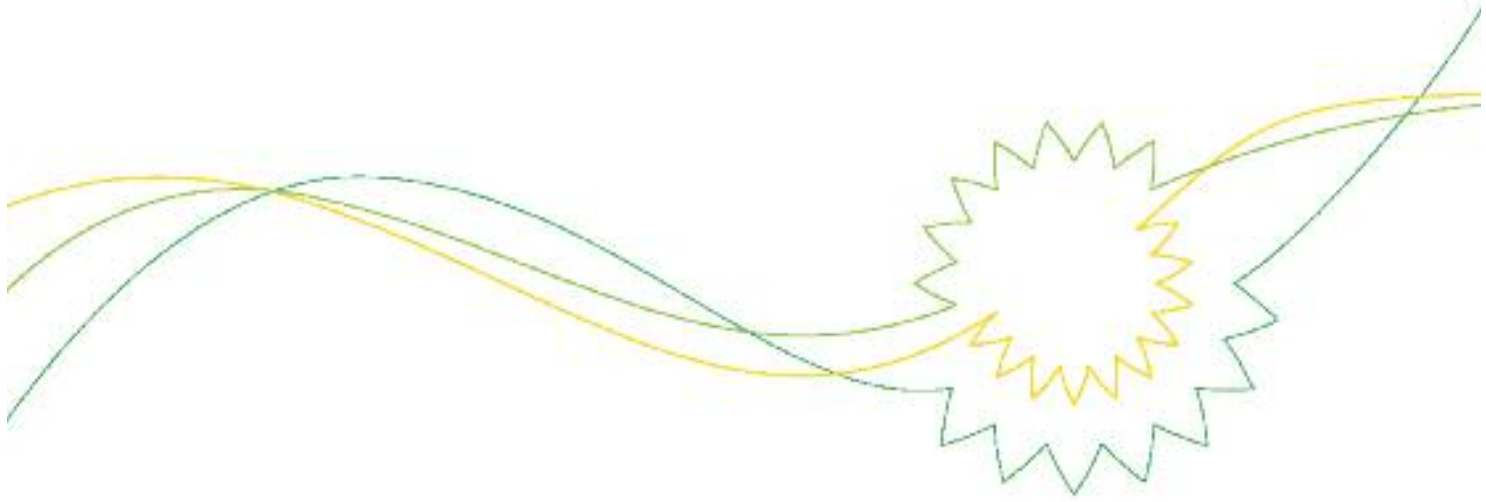

2011 PCA Finals

Over the past year, the Professional Cowboy Association's cowboys and cowgirls have given their all for a chance to participate in the PCA Finals Rodeo at the Mississippi Coast Coliseum in Biloxi. Their performance over the 2011 season determines their eligibility for the finals, allowing the top athletes of each event to compete for prizes in front of thousands of rodeo fans. This year's purse totaled over a quarter-million, along with commemorative belts and saddles for the event champions.

On January 19, the Mississippi Coast Coliseum opened its doors for the first night of the Finals Rodeo. While fans lined up outside for tickets, the participants and staff worked intently to prepare for the big night. In the back of the building, cowboys and cowgirls congregated by the chutes, their spurs clacking until they reached the red dirt. Before the start of each night's events, riders were welcome to join a brief devotional in the hall. Waiting in the wings, each of the contestants wore a black finals jacket, which bore the PCA logo as well as Bartlett Ranch's "Flying B." They adjusted their saddles and buckled their boots. The contestants in the bucking events limbered up by the wall, knowing that they had earlier chosen the best bucking animals in the rodeo. The ropers ran lengths of rope through their hands as the truck-loading door opened behind them. The horses filed in and gathered behind the gates. It wouldn't be long before the competition started.



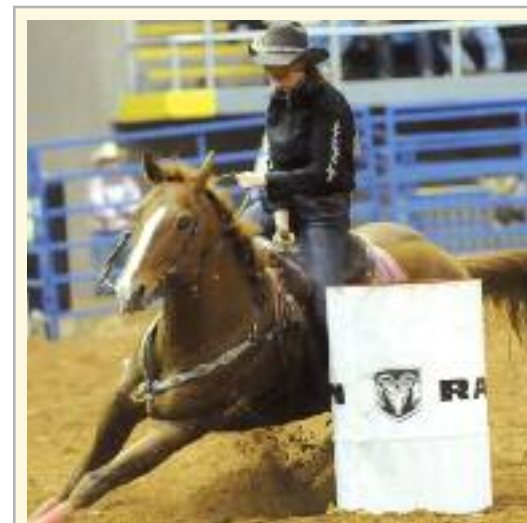
As the coliseum filled with spectators, announcer Clint Allemand greeted the audience and introduced a memorial video of the PCA's Hall of Fame members. He then offered a special recognition for Dr. Woody Bartlett, thanking him for his incredible support in making the rodeo such a success.

At 7:30, the lights dimmed and the PCA logo shone on the arena floor. Fans returned from the concession stands and merchant booths for a tribute to the armed forces, followed by the national anthem. Allemand introduced the sponsors, then encouraged the crowd to welcome the rodeo finalists. The Southeast's top cowboys and cowgirls rode in after the sponsor flags and tipped their hats to the audience. Allemand congratulated the "best in the PCA" for all their hard work leading up to the finals, and reminded the audience that they were watching the best riders and best horses from around the South.



The finals consisted of eight events: bareback riding, calf roping, saddle bronc riding, steer wrestling, breakaway roping, barrel racing, team roping, and bull riding. Matt Smith kicked off the night with a solid ride. He remained on the bucking horse for the required time and won the night's go around. He would later be declared the bareback champion on Sunday. Over the four nights of rodeo, riders made their best efforts to stay on the bucking horses. As finalists, they were given the opportunity to choose which stock contractors would provide the horses and bulls. The best animals buck hard, allowing the riders to perform to the best of their ability.

Each of the stock contractors participating in the finals must have 5 rodeos a year in order to qualify. Some have over 30. The horses they provide are second to none. Riders had to endure serious bucking, but were rewarded by big scores if they could manage to stay on for qualifying time.



The finals weekend featured top-notch talent and amazing effort from all the contestants. Even with years of experience and awards, the competitors still faced challenges every night. With so much happening in a matter of seconds, and the high physical demand of the events, it's easy to overlook a simple rule and earn a disqualification or extra time for the round. With competition so tight, riders cannot afford to break the barrier in steer wrestling or tip a barrel during the barrel racing. "It's a tough challenge for everybody," says barrel racer Rhonda Dobbins. In speed-focused events like barrel racing, every second counts. "Even if you're really doing well, the competition is still close" says Stephanie Bryant, who scored 12.931 seconds on Friday night. "These girls could race against anybody."

By the final day of the rodeo, Champion Day, the audience was pouring in from around the South, driving through a thick coastal fog to the coliseum. Each night, rodeo clown and PCA veteran Reggie Purvis would take a crowd survey to see where the fans had traveled from. Several Southeastern states were well represented, with many from Alabama and Mississippi.

After the last round of events, the crowd stayed to see who would be declared the 2011 PCA Finals Rodeo champions. As the winners crossed the arena to claim their saddles and other prizes, their horses were lead out the truck-loading doors. After they received their awards, the contestants would return home and prepare for the next rodeo season. Everyone involved with the PCA worked hard to make the rodeo a success, and their efforts lead to another successful year.

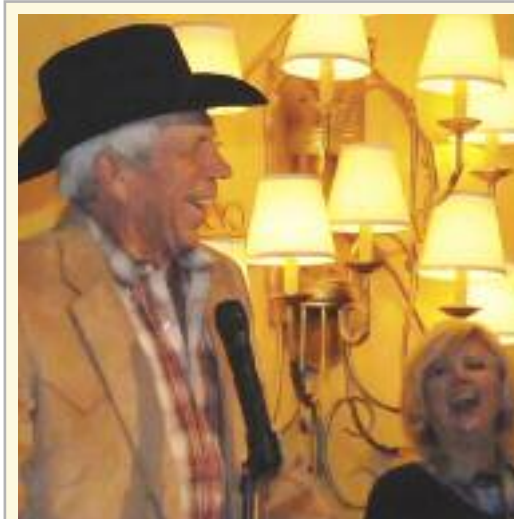
